

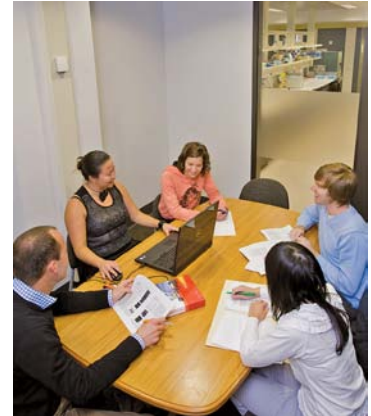
Postgraduate Programmes in Clinical Education:

Postgraduate Certificate in Clinical Education (PGCertClinEd)
Postgraduate Diploma in Clinical Education (PGDipClinEd)
Master of Clinical Education (MClinEd)

CMHSE offers a comprehensive postgraduate degree programme in Clinical Education of particular relevance clinicians involved in medical undergraduate, pre-vocational or vocational education and training, clinical nurse educators, and other health professionals with a role in education.

On-line learning: all courses are delivered on line, allowing busy clinicians the flexibility to complete course work in their own time. On-line activities promote engagement with other students.

Workshops: most courses offer a 1-2 day workshop held at the Grafton Campus.



Clinical Education taught courses include:

ClinEd 715 Clinical Teaching

Provides a conceptual framework of the principles of adult education for teaching and learning in the clinical setting. (30 points, Semester 1)

ClinEd 716 Assessing Clinical Performance

Explores the purpose, criteria, methods, standard setting and examiner training for a range of assessments, with a focus on ensuring competence to practice. (30 points, Semester 2)

ClinEd 703 Learning in Small Groups

Explores how clinicians operate as members and leaders of groups, and the conditions underlying effective group function both in education and the workplace. (15 points, Semester 2)

ClinEd 712 Curriculum and Course Design

Explores theory, concepts and processes that underlie curriculum development and the design of short courses for a clinical setting. (15 points, Semester 1)

ClinEd 714 Research Methods in Clinical Education

Incorporates theories in educational research methodologies (quantitative and qualitative) with practical research issues relevant to clinical settings. (15 points, Semester 2)

ClinEd 705 Simulation and Clinical Skills Teaching

Addresses theory and practice around the use of simulators in clinical education. (15 points, Semester 1)

ClinEd 706 Interprofessional Learning in the Health Professions

Explores and evaluates the evidence base on interprofessional learning in the health professions. (15 points, Semester 2)

ClinEd 711 E-learning and Clinical Education

Develops the knowledge and skills to critically evaluate E-learning in the clinical setting. (15 points, Semester 1)

ClinEd 713 Clinical Supervision

Develops a critical approach towards workplace learning and supervising students and trainees in the clinical setting. (15 points, Semester 1)

ClinEd 708 & 709 Advanced Studies in Evaluation / Assessment

Supervised research on an assessment topic approved by the Head of the CMHSE. (15 points, both semesters)
