Māori and Pacific Admission Scheme (MAPAS)

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The MAPAS MH04 form must be submitted by the following application closing dates:

MBChB and BPharm: 1 November 2011

BHSc, BNurs and CertHSc: 8 December 2011

Please Note:

- Submission of the MAPAS MH04 form does not constitute a formal programme application.
- Please ensure that you have applied online to the University of Auckland for the programmes you would like to study in 2012. If you have not done so, go to www.auckland.ac.nz/applynow to access the online application form.
- A hardcopy of the MH04 form must be received in the MAPAS office by noon on the due date. If using the postal system you must ensure that you allow for internal/external mailing delays to guarantee that the MH04 form is received in hardcopy by the due date. Applications received after the due date due to postal error/delays will be considered late applications.
- Late programme and/or MAPAS applications for MBChB and BPharm will not be accepted. MAPAS applications for BHSc, BNurs and CertHSc received after the 8 December are considered to be late applications and are not guaranteed a MAPAS interview.
- **MAPAS interview places are limited; priority will be given to those who meet the ancestry requirements for MAPAS along with the appropriate academic or life experience as required by FMHS**
- You must be a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident, and entry criteria into Faculty of Medical and Health Sciences must be adhered to, before we consider your eligibility for MAPAS. - **Please ensure** you have completed **ALL** sections of the MH04 form. We do not accept incomplete forms.
 - An official record of your NCEA Level 2 results **must** be submitted with the MH04 form, if you are applying as a school leaver.
 - A copy of your tertiary transcript must be submitted with the MH04 form if you are a non-school leaver applicant.
 - You must include a named passport sized photo with your MH04 application.
