

Operative Management of Liver Trauma

The course is designed for general surgeons and theatre nursing staff and is designed to up skill both surgeon and theatre nurses in operative techniques for the management of severe liver trauma. Ideally a surgeon attending will bring a member of the theatre nursing team.

Topics include:

- Anaesthetic and transfusion issues.
- The place of radiology.
- Advanced surgical techniques for damage & haemorrhage control
- Structuring and leading the theatre team

The course is limited to 12 participants on a "first come, first served" basis, i.e. six surgeons & six nurses.
