

Postgraduate student money in the School of Medicine

This money is available on a yearly basis to support the work of postgraduate research students. This money must be spent by the end of each year (31 December).

By the end of February Heads of Departments advise the School of Medicine Manager of their enrolled doctoral and masters research students. From this information money is allocated for HODs to use to support postgraduate research student work in discussion with their supervisors. Once the student is 'out of time' this money is not available for them.

The sums which are available in 2010 are as follows:

	'Wet' (laboratory work)	'Dry' (other)
PhD and MD	\$3600	\$1800
Masters Thesis	\$1800	\$900
Masters Dissertation	\$900	\$450
BSc Hons	\$900	\$450

This funding is to be used at the discretion of the supervisors with approval of their HOD for necessities similar to those which the PReSS account can be used for.
