

## Suggested pathway for Health Services Management.

### Options:

A programme in Health Services Management can be taken as:

- (a) PGDipPH – in which case, the 30 point course POPLHLTH 716 (Foundations of Public Health) would be taken first as usual, plus one of the compulsory 15 point “research” courses listed and five other 15 point courses from below as required to make 120 points.
- (b) PGDipHSc: For those who do not wish to do POPLHLTH 716, a compulsory 15 point “research” course as listed plus seven other 15 point courses from below to make 120 points.
