

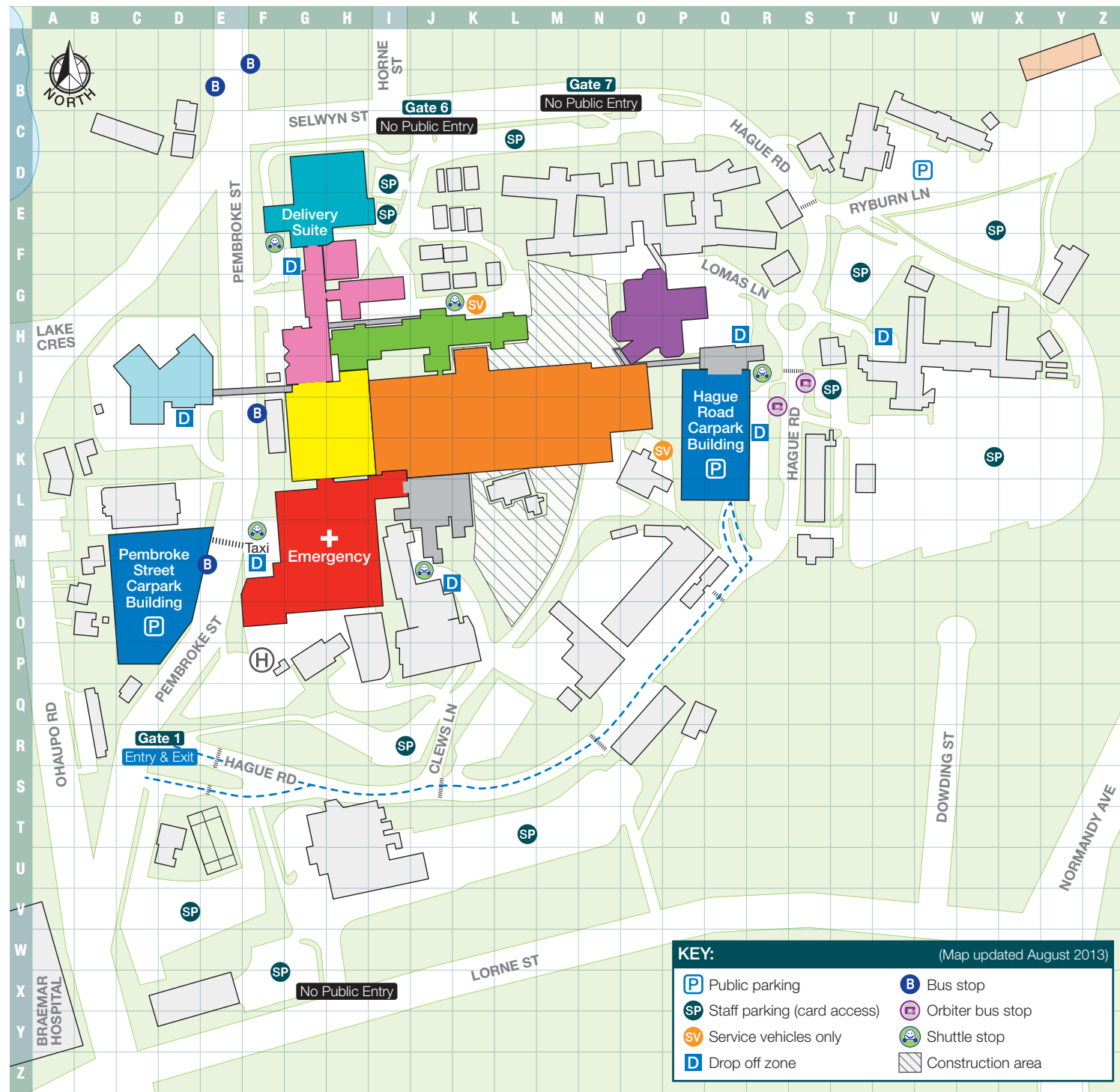
# Waikato Hospital campus map

Waikato Waikato Hospital campus has a free shuttle service for patients and visitors circulating the hospital every 15-20 minutes from 7am-6pm Monday-Friday. The shuttlebugs are similar to golf carts and the shuttlebuses are vans that can transport wheelchairs and pushchairs. Catch a shuttle from one of the shuttle stops or ask a Hospital Host or receptionist to call one for you from the area you are visiting.
